Anthrosphere

That part of the environment that is made or modified by humans for use in human activities



Geosphere

Part of the Earth system that includes the Earth's interior, rocks & minerals, landforms & the processes that shape the Earth's surface

Hydrosphere

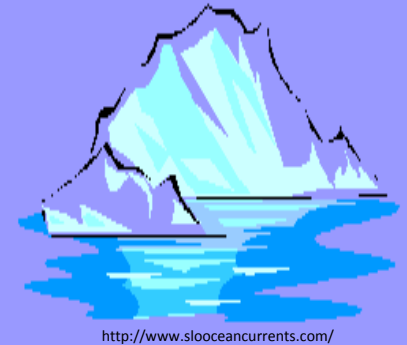
Part of the Earth system that includes the water on the surface of the Earth; oceans, seas, lakes, ponds, rivers and streams
